What is the TEAS?

The Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS), developed by ATI, assesses preparedness to enter the health science fields. You've probably been asked to take the TEAS as part of admissions requirements for a nursing or allied health program. That's because studies show a consistent link between TEAS scores and future academic success.

Test structure
